



Information for our neighbours

St Agnes' Catholic Primary School

Sydney Catholic Schools has been considering how to redevelop our school site in Matraville to better use our existing footprint.

As you may have noticed, early construction works on a two-storey school building adjacent to Norfolk Lane commenced in September 2021. Works are continuing this year, with completion estimated for late 2022.

We are now preparing to lodge a development application for a new three-storey school building to be located on the southwest area of the school grounds between Bunnerong Road and Norfolk Lane. This building will include ground floor covered parking, learning spaces on the middle floor and an early learning centre on the top level. The development application also includes provision for additional learning areas if needed in the future.

This update is being provided to our neighbours for early visibility of our planned program.

What is the planning process?

1. Sydney Catholic Schools will lodge a development application with Randwick City Council in the near future.
2. The application will be subject to a public notification period set by Council. Information submitted with the application will be made available by Council to the general public. Interested parties can make a submission to Council during this public notification period.
3. The proposal will then be assessed by Council and referred to the Eastern Sydney Planning Panel for determination.

What is the purpose of the redevelopment?

The purpose of the project is to revitalise our school site and provide quality, flexible and contemporary teaching and learning spaces. We are preparing our school site to cater for the future amalgamation with Our Lady of the Annunciation Catholic Primary School.

How will I be kept updated?

We remain committed to keeping our neighbours informed and will continue letterbox drops as needed and in line with compliance requirements.
